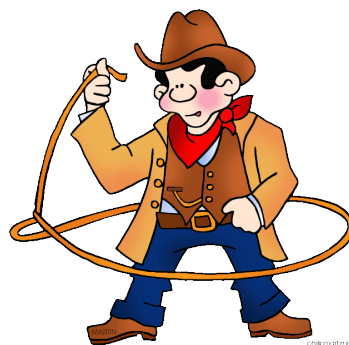

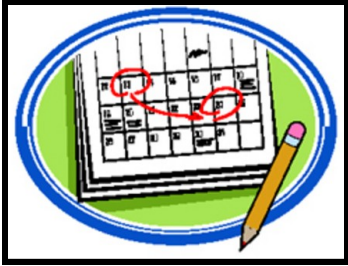


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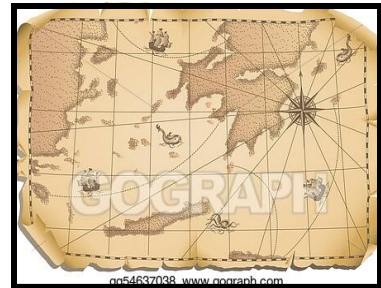

OPA Website Reform Coming



A new look is coming soon to the OPA website.!

Dave Warrington has been working with website designer Justin Benner, to create a sleeker, simpler website for OPA. The website will include an event calendar and the ability to complete Campout Registration Forms online.

Dave also plans to design a “Registration Template” that will consist of 2 parts. One part will identify the event and can be designed by the organizers themselves but the second part will be a fixed template that collects specific information that is consistent from campout to campout. Once everything is in place, Dave will essentially become the OPA webmaster. He is currently receiving training so as to understand all of the possibilities at our disposal. Dave is working with our new website host, who is guiding him through the proper process of divorcing us from our existing webmaster. The cost for hosting this new website is estimated at \$300 or less annually. Our website sponsor just renewed his \$250 sponsorship, so the actual annual cost to OPA is not likely to exceed \$50.

Dave will be the one who keeps the new website up-to-date, but remember, he’s totally a volunteer, and also adjusting to this new learning curve, so let’s all be patient, OK? Please do send him your announcements, photos, articles, change of email addresses etc., and he’ll do his best to get things posted in a timely manner. Dave would like each chapter to send him a photo to attach to their chapter information.

Dave and Justin hope to launch this new website on or before Dec. 1, 2021.
