
#### Future Growth Depends on Embracing Technology:

The FCRV Trustees have recognized the need to create an online presence in order to attract new members. Here in Ontario, we are also working towards this goal. Our new OPA website is simple to use and contains tons of information. Visitors can quickly see who we are, what we do, and where our future campouts will be. They can even become members directly through the website by filling in the application form. They can visit the photo gallery and read the Blog to see how much fun we have. They can scroll through our OPAction Newsletters and become further informed. They can even "Contact Us" with the click of a button if they have any questions or comments. How easy is that?

#### Online Registration

One of the best features of the new OPA website is the ability to register and pay online for any OPA campout. This is wonderful for anyone who does online banking...which is almost all young folks these days. (Most of them don't even own cheques.) This also saves postage and time. E-transfer payments to opafinancial@gmail.com go directly to our OPA Treasurer. This eliminates the costly set up of a separate bank account for organizers of an OPA function.

Unfortunately any non-OPA campout, like the Retiree Rally, will <u>not</u> be able to pay through opafinancial. But they can still register quickly and easily online, and send the payments separately as directed by the organizers.
